Intensive Korean Language Program

- A structured 10-week course designed for Korean language study and academic preparation.
- Korean language to develop practical communication skills and Korean culture classes related to the Korean language program.

1. Target Students

Male and Female foreigners or overseas Koreans with at least high school graduation

2. Required Documents

1) For Non Visa Applicants

- Online Application
- Please register online first (<https://atom.ewha.ac.kr/>)
- A copy of passport
- A copy of alien registration card
(both of front and back pages, Only for visa holders)
- A copy of graduation diploma from the most recently attended school
AND a copy of certificate of enrollment(only for current university students)

2) For D-4 Visa Applicants (Visa-Waiver Country)

- and ② are the same with 'For Non Visa Applicants'
- An original version of graduation diploma from the most recently attended school with Apostille
AND a copy of certificate of enrollment(only for current university students)
- An original version of the most recent bank balance statement letter under the applicant's name, or their parent's name.
(with the balance of 10,000,000 KRW for 2 semesters registration.
D-4 visa must be applied within 30 days from the date of issuance.
In case of submitting parent's bank balance statement, please submit an original version of "documentary evidence of family relation")

3. Registration procedure

- Online Application and submit documents via email
- ⇒ Required documents submission via post(only for D-4 applicants)
- ⇒ Completion of document screening notice via e-mail
- ⇒ Tuition Payment
- ⇒ (ONLY for D-4 applicants: Issuance of certification of admission for Visa application ⇒ Visa application and acquisition)
- ⇒ Taking the placement test before the start of semester (Written and Speaking test)
- ⇒ Admission
- * After completing the online application, you must also notify the Ewha Language Center via email(kfl2@ewha.ac.kr).
- * If applying for a visa, original documents must be submitted by postal mail.
- * If not applying for a visa, all documents may be submitted as image files (JPG, PDF).
- * Additional documents may be requested if necessary.
- * Documents written in languages other than English, Chinese, or Japanese must be submitted with a notarized Korean or English translation.
- * Students in the Intensive Program will be automatically enrolled in insurance. (Included in the tuition fee)

4. Intensive Korean Language Program Academic Credit Transfer

- Maximum 6 credits can be approved toward graduation credits for the students in their first semester who have been admitted to Ewha Womans University's Bachelor program within 1 year after completing ELC's Intensive Korean Language Program level 4~6.
(ELC will individually notify the students who meet this condition)

5. ELC Scholarship

ELC Sibling Scholarship	Supporting scholarship for students whose siblings are simultaneously enrolled in Korean courses at ELC
ELC Scholarship of Excellence in Korean Language	Supporting certain amount for 2 international freshman students (transfer students are not eligible) of Ewha Womans University, who have both passed at least 3 semester and completed level 6 of Intensive Korean Language Program at Ewha Language Center
Scholarship for Outstanding Korean Learners	Supporting 50% of tuition fees to the attendees of the Intensive Program who received the best grades in each level and re-register for the next semester (provided only once)

* Students can only receive one scholarship per semester.

Dormitory application

1. Application period

- Intensive Korean Language Program: 2 months before the semester
- Short-term Korean Language Program: 1~2 months before the semester
- * Dormitory is assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.
- * Short-term program students can only apply for dorms during the summer vacation (July to August) and winter vacation (February) of Ewha Womans University.
- * Application results will be notified individually by e-mail within 2 weeks after the application deadline.

Short-term Korean Language Program

- A short-term program for foreigners visiting on vacation or break who wish to study Korean (3 weeks)
- Conduct culture classes to help students understand Korean culture and life

1. Target students

Male and female foreigners or overseas Koreans enrolled in OR have graduated from high school

2. Required documents

- Online Application
- Please register online first (<https://atom.ewha.ac.kr/>)
 - A copy of passport
 - A copy of the alien registration card
(both of front and back pages, Only for visa holders)
 - A copy of graduation diploma from the most recently attended school
OR a copy of certificate of enrollment
 - Photo (JPG format only)
-file name must be named after your passport name in English
- * If you are from a Non visa-waiver country, please submit a copy of your visa as well.
 - * ELC does not support visa application to the short-term students. Only a receipt for the tuition fee can be issued upon request.
 - * For the safety of students, we recommend students to join insurance for international students.

3. Registration process

- Online registration ⇒ Submission of documents by e-mail
- ⇒ Confirmation of all required documents by email ⇒ Tuition payment
- ⇒ Taking the online placement test before the semester starts (Written and Speaking test)
- ⇒ Admission
- * After completing the online application, you must also notify the Ewha Language Center via email(kfl2@ewha.ac.kr).
- * Please scan the documents and submit them in JPG or PDF file
- * Additional documents submission can be requested if necessary.

- Admission fee is non-refundable in case of course cancellation.
- Please make a deposit considering the exchange rate and commission.
- The certificate of admission for a D-4 visa can only be issued when full tuition fee has been paid.

2. Payment method

- After document screening, payment information will be sent to each applicant via email.
- The remittance receipt must include the sender's name (student's name), the remitted amount, and the account holder's name.
