## Intensive Korean Language Program

- A systemized Intensive Korean Language program for foreign students wishing to pursue Korean language training or preparing for their studies in Korea (10 weeks)
- Practical communication skills
- Korean culture programs offered in relation to the curriculum

### 1. Target Students

Male and female foreigners or overseas Koreans with at least graduation from high school

### 2. Required Documents

#### ※ For D-4 Visa Applicants (Visa-Waiver Country)

- Online application
- Please register online first (<http://atom.ewha.ac.kr>)
- A copy of passport
- A graduation (or enrollment) certificate of the most recently attended school with Apostille or verified by Korean Embassy
- Bank statement letter under the applicant's name with the balance of 10,000,000 KRW or more for 2 semesters registration
- Must be issued before 1 month at most at the point ELC receive the original document by international post
- Additional documents may be requested upon need.
- If you are attending university, please submit a certificate of enrollment.
- All required documents which are not written in English, Chinese, and Japanese should be translated English/Korean and notarized from the legal office.
- Once all of the required documents are submitted, the document screening process starts.
- After the completion of screening, Certificate of Admission would be issued.

#### ※ Non Visa-Waiver Country

- An original passport photo
- Online application
- Please register online first (<http://atom.ewha.ac.kr>)
- A copy of passport
- A graduation (or enrollment) certificate from the most recently attended school with Apostille or verified by Korean Embassy
- Bank statement letter under the applicant's name with the balance of 10,000,000 KRW or more for 2 semesters registration
- Must be issued before 1 month at most at the point ELC receive the original document by international post
- A certificate of both parents' employment (original, translated and then notarized)
- A certificate of income of both parents (original, translated and then notarized)
- A certificate of family relation (original, translated and then notarized)
- Certificate of Korean sponsorship (Notarized by legal office, original copy)
- The sponsor must have Korean nationality
- Designated form ([http://www.hikorea.go.kr/pt/main\\_en.pt](http://www.hikorea.go.kr/pt/main_en.pt))
- A copy of Korean Sponsor's ID card
- A certificate of employment or business license of the Korean sponsor
- Additional documents may be requested upon need.
- If you are attending university, please submit a certificate of enrollment.
- All required documents which are not written in English, Chinese, and Japanese should be translated English/Korean and notarized from the legal office.
- Once all of the required documents are submitted, the document screening process starts.
- After the completion of screening, Certificate of Admission would be issued.

#### ※ If you do not have to apply for Visa

- Online application
- Please register online first (<http://atom.ewha.ac.kr>)
- A copy of passport
- A copy of the alien registration card (only for current visa holders)
- A graduation (or enrollment) certificate of the most recently attended school
- Additional documents may be requested upon need.
- If you are attending university, please submit a certificate of enrollment
- All required documents which are not written in English, Chinese, and Japanese should be translated English/Korean and notarized from the legal office.

### 3. Registration procedure

Online application ⇒ Required documents submission by email first, and then by post ⇒ Completion of document screening notice via e-mail ⇒ Tuition payment ⇒ Issuance of certificate of admission for Visa application ⇒ Visa application and acquisition ⇒ Admission ⇒ Taking the placement test before the start of semester (Vocabulary, Reading, Writing and Speaking test)

※ If you apply for visa, please submit the original document by international post.

If you do not apply for visa, please submit the scanned copy of required documents via email.

### 4. Intensive Korean Language Program Academic Credit Transfer

Maximum 6 credits can be approved toward graduation credits for the students in their first semester who have been admitted to Ewha Womans University's Bachelor program within 1 year after completing ELC's Intensive Korean Language program level 4-6. (ELC will individually give a notice to the students who meet this condition stated above)

### 5. ELC Scholarships

ELC Siblings Scholarship	Supporting scholarship for students whose brothers or sisters simultaneously take Korean courses at Ewha Language Center
ELC Scholarship of Excellence in Korean Language	Supporting certain amount for 2 international freshman students (transfer students are not eligible) of Ewha Womans University, who have both passed at least 3 semesters and completed level 6 of Intensive Korean Language program at Ewha Language Center
Scholarship for Outstanding Korean Learners	Supporting 50% of tuition fees to the attendees of the Intensive Program who receive the best grades in each level and re-register for the next semester (benefit can be provided only once)

※ Students can only receive one scholarship per semester.

## Dormitory application

### 1. Application period

- Intensive Korean Language Program: Apply on a first-come, first-served basis at <http://atom.ewha.ac.kr> two months before the start of the semester
- Short-term Korean Language Program: Apply on a first-come, first-served basis at <http://atom.ewha.ac.kr> one month before the start of the semester
- Short-term program students can only apply for dorms during the summer vacation (July to August) and winter vacation (February) of Ewha Womans University.
- Application results will be notified individually by e-mail within two weeks after the application deadline.

## Short-term Korean Language Program

- A short-term program for foreigners visiting on vacation or break who wish to study Korean (3 weeks)
- Conduct cultural classes to help students understand Korean culture and life

### 1. Target students

Male and female foreigners or overseas Koreans (Korean living abroad) enrolled in OR have graduated from high school

### 2. Required documents

- An admission application (Ewha Language Center form)
- Register online on the Ewha Language Center website (<http://atom.ewha.ac.kr>)
- A copy of passport
- A certificate of graduation or enrollment from the final education
- A copy of the alien registration card (only for current visa holders)
- If you are from a Non visa-waiver country, please submit a copy of your visa as well.
- ELC does not offer the required documents for the visa application to the short-term program students. However, a receipt for the tuition fee can be issued upon request
- For the safety of students, we recommend students to join insurance for international students. Those who have joined insurance, please submit a copy of insurance certificate.

### 3. Registration process

Online registration ⇒ Submission of documents by e-mail ⇒ Confirmation of all required documents ⇒ Tuition payment ⇒ Admission ⇒ Taking the placement test before the semester starts (vocabulary, reading, and speaking test)

※ Please scan the documents and submit them in image files.

※ Additional documents can be requested if necessary.

Student counseling office	Operate a student counseling room consisted of faculty members of the Ewha Language Center to help students learn and live successfully. (English, Japanese, and Chinese interpretation available)
Cultural classes and excursions	For each semester, cultural programs such as exhibitions, performances, and field-trips are conducted under the theme of Korean pop culture, traditional culture, etc. In addition, a Korean speech contest is held to provide a venue for cultural exchange.
